



Tarzana Treatment Center to Increase Efficiency and Security with eWebHealth Medical Record Workflow Technology

BURLINGTON, Mass., May 22, 2007 — Tarzana Treatment Centers, Inc., a full-service behavioral health organization headquartered in Tarzana, Calif., has selected services from eWebHealth, the technology division of medical record innovator ChartOne, Inc., to reduce the amount of labor and time involved in processing patient charts as well as better protect the information they contain.

Tarzana is a non-profit, community-based organization that operates a psychiatric hospital, residential and outpatient treatment centers and family medical clinics. The organization originally was seeking an electronic alternative for storing patient medical records. California demands a seven-year retention period for all records after patient discharge, which can mean a significant accumulation of paper that is at risk due to the area's potential natural disasters.

“eWebHealth is the only technology of its kind on the market, so the choice was clear,” said Tarzana CEO Scott Taylor. “We found several scanning and storage options but were immediately impressed by the range of functionality eWebHealth offered, particularly its chart completion capabilities. Additionally, eWebHealth security features allow users to limit or restrict access to patient records as well as track who has viewed them, a characteristic that is very important to us as well as our patients.”

The eWebHealth Suite is a group of medical record workflow solutions that healthcare organizations can use via a software-as-a-service delivery model, so they can achieve the benefits of “any time, anywhere” record access without lengthy or costly technology implementation cycles. Tarzana will use three eWebHealth services: eWebView™, which gives clinicians, patient accounts, health information management staff, auditors and others access to patient records via the Internet; eWebCompletion™, which makes it easy for physicians to comply with medical record requirements by supporting electronic deficiency analysis, assignment, routing, monitoring and reporting; and eWebSignature™, which allows clinicians to sign charts wherever and whenever they have Web access.

“Not only are we able to reduce the cost of storing massive quantities of paper for Tarzana, but our eWebHealth technology gives their facilities state-of-the-art record workflow, accessibility and security features,” said ChartOne CEO Brian Cahill. “For even smaller organizations, eWebHealth directs the flow of health information to the point of impact easily, affordably, and with proven return on investment.”
